Notice of EDI Element Requirement Table Change: New Mandatory Fields

Effective April 9, 2015, Montana will begin returning a TR (Transaction Rejected) for FROI and SROI submissions that do not contain the following new mandatory data elements. The TPA information must be for the actual in-state office processing the claim.

- DN0008 Third Party Administrator FEIN (*148-FROI & A49-SROI*)
- DN0009 Third Party Administrator Name (*148-FROI*)
- DN0014 Claim Administrator Postal Code – 9 digit, if available (*148-FROI & A49-SROI*)

Per the IAIABC Claims Release 1 standard, these data elements are not required for insurers who are administering their own claims. However, if possible, we would appreciate if insurers could send these data elements.

Additionally, although not mandatory elements, the following would be appreciated:

- DN0010 Claim Administrator Address Line 1 (*148-FROI*)
- DN0012 Claim Administrator City (*148-FROI*)
- DN0033 Postal Code of Injury Site (*148-FROI*)

Although the effective date is April 9th, we would appreciate submission of these data elements as soon as Trading Partners are able.
