The law prohibits retaliation for filing a complaint, being a witness or opposing a discriminatory practice.

Discrimination is illegal if it is based on:

Age (all), race, color, national origin, religion, creed
Physical or mental disability
Marital status, Vaccination Status
Sex (includes pregnancy)
Familial status (housing only) Political belief (government employment or service)

You cannot be retaliated against for complaining about discrimination or participating in an investigation.
