Note: pre-hearing time is charged for administration, pre-hearing conferences, and other pre-hearing activity totaling over an hour.

A per-diem fee is charged for each eight-hour day of travel, hearing, study, and writing. The full per-diem is charged for all hearing days. More than one day's per-diem is charged and pro-rated for hearing or travel extending beyond eight hours on a hearing day. Study and writing for less than a full day are pro-rated.

cancellation, 1 day, if cancelled or postponed within 20 days of the date of hearing. One day plus half of all scheduled days beyond the first if within 10 days of first days. All scheduled days if within 5 days.
