#### Board Action - Case for Oral Argument (04:39):

**Petitioner: Thomas Flowers** 

Counter Petitioner: Fish Wildlife and Parks

Case #202011240

Board Chair Brian Hopkins confirmed all documents provided to the Board were reviewed by Board Members.

Eric Holm, representing (Petitioner) Thomas Flowers, presented his oral argument. Holm argues that Fish Wildlife and Parks owed Flowers due process rights before terminating him. Holms maintains the Hearing Officer failed to require FWP to meet the burden of proof to show just cause for this termination. Holm asks that the Hearing Officers Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order be rejected and reversed, as it was based upon clear error and an unconstitutional burden shift.

Jamie MacNaughton, representing the Counter Petitioner(s) Fish Wildlife and Parks, presented her oral argument in this matter. MacNaughton argues that Fish Wildlife and Parks provided competent and substantial evidence that proves due process was given.
