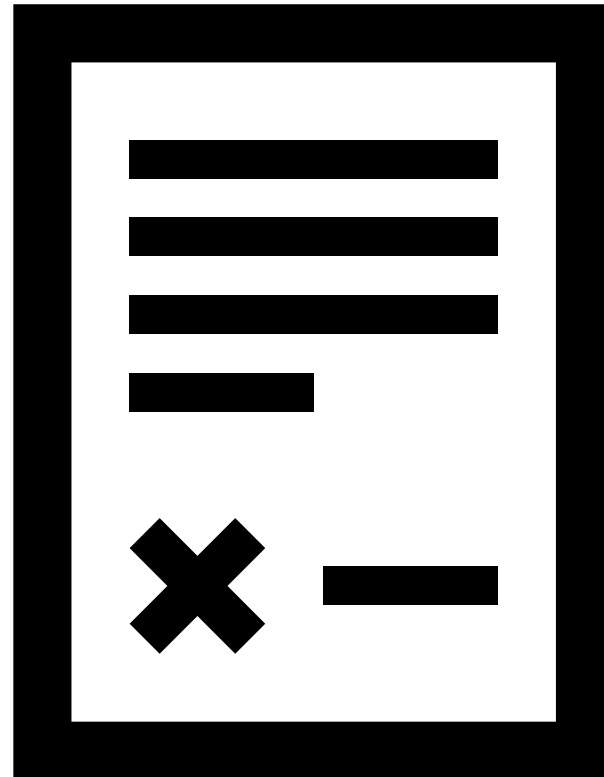

Notices: Denial, 14-Day Termination and Reservation of Rights

By MCA Statutes 39-71-606, 39-71-609, 39-71-608, and 39-71-615, the department and injured worker must be noticed any time a claim is denied, benefits have been terminated, or the claim has been placed under reservation of rights. Notices must be submitted to the department by electronically entering them through the portal, [ERD - Notice Web](#).
