#### **Utilization & Treatment Guidelines**



The 2011 Montana legislature passed Montana Code Annotated 39-71-704, requiring that "the department, in consultation with health care providers with relevant experience and education, shall provide for an annual review of the evidence-based utilization and treatment guidelines to consider amendments or changes to the guidelines."



#### **Process Overview**



Determine the scope of the guideline



Search for and retrieve evidence



Complete an initial draft of the guideline



Task force is convened



Advisory panel convened



Rule hearing



Guideline published - 01/01/25



New step: Guideline Advisory

Group to identify new or

controversial issues in the

system before completing

review of the evidence

#### **Goals with Recent Colorado Updates**

General formatting update

Integrate General Guideline Principles into the guideline content

- Highlight functional improvement
- Emphasize active over passive therapies

Focus the Guideline content

Make it easier for providers to use the guidelines

Improve application of recommendations



#### **Shoulder Injury Guideline**

Made recommendations actionable and the main focus of the content

- Defined and used "acceptable" for treatments
- Removed ambiguity
- Continued to remove education
- No evidence statements mixed in



#### **DLI Internal Review**

- Internally edit to ensure language is consistent with Montana statute and rule
- Incorporate MPG edits from prior drafts for consistency

#### **Montana Medical Provider Group 2025**

Montana medical providers reviewed the Shoulder Injury Guideline content and met to discuss proposed updates.

Edits were made to the Guideline.

Associated administrative rule updates are anticipated in September 2025 to adopt the updated Shoulder Injury Guideline.

#### **Updates to other chapters**

Clean up several items in the existing guidelines

- Update credential and scope of practice information for behavioral health and psychological providers, as in Low Back Pain and Cervical Spine Injury guidelines.
- Removing the need for a full psychological evaluation prior to initiating cognitive behavioral therapy.
- Removing vague language in the *Positive Patient*Response general guideline principle.

## Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM) considerations

- (3) The DLI Medical Director may make interim administrative edits to the Montana Utilization and Treatment Guidelines content in specific circumstances.
  - (a) For content accuracy with respect to provider scope of practice and licensure in Montana.
  - (b) For content accuracy with respect to legislative mandates and statutory or administrative rules.
  - (c) To resolve or remove vague or potentially problematic language.
  - (d) For general corrections, formatting, or style updates.
